The International Seed Testing Association (ISTA) and the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) have a great pleasure to announce the ISTA/FAO Training Course on Seed Quality Testing. This Training Course is for seed testing analysts from selected counties of the African region, namely ECOWAS countries and Kenya, Malawi, South Africa, Tanzania, Uganda and Zambia. The aim of the course is to provide hand-on experience to technicians and seed testing technologists, and straightened cooperation and information exchange in the field of seed testing in the region. The training course will include lectures and practical work.

Considering the above, participants should be actual technicians, with at least a basic knowledge or experience in seed testing.

Kindly note that funds can be secured for 20 participants, covering accommodation for 4 nights, food during the course period and travel expenses. Travel expenses of a maximum of US\$400 will be reimbursed upon participants' arrival to the course venue. Participants are advised to keep their travel tickets in order to facilitate reimbursement. Furthermore, each participant will upon arrival receive US\$50 contribution towards miscellaneous expenses.

The course is limited to 20 participants! Seed analysts can apply for the participation with the attached **registration form and a short curriculum vitae** about their working experiences and technical duties which they performed in their laboratory. - > Seed Collections, Systematics, use of the GRIN System, Literature
- Preparation for Germination testing in the laboratory
- Germination Testing and evaluation
- Germination, evaluation of abnormal seedlings in mono- and di-cotyledons
- Use of tolerance tables, calculation and reporting of hard and fresh seed
- Tetrazolium testing for the determination of un-germinated seed
- Viability, Germination and Vigour
- The ISTA Accreditation Standard, Quality Assurance in the laboratory: staff and equipment
